Auctioneers Comments:

An increased entry and as fireworks annual go up, so does the trade. Bonfire night is always a date to mark on the calendar as abattoirs start to buy forward for Christmas. Early November always brings a lift and thereafter trade over the Christmas period will be determined by supply. This year cattle have had a difficult Summer and are not as far forward as usual. This year supply could be tight as cattle are plainer and are being housed later. They will take longer to get going on winter rations and have less time to do it in. This could be the Christmas that well finished cattle pay their way. Top of the sale was a lean R (no better) grade roan Limousin heifer, 462kg, from Messrs RJ & AM Pedrick, Buckfastleigh, which sold exceptionally well at 169ppk. Quality shapely red Limousin heifers from Messrs Day & Son, Bridport, met strong demand at 164.5ppk twice, with a similar Charolais from the same farm at 158.5ppk. A shapely lean Blue from Mr CJM Shackleton, Wiveliscombe achieved 159.5ppk, with a light weight Blue (480kg) from the same farm at 149.5ppk. The 160ppk barrier was also hit by Mr J Baker, Mark, with a shapely well fleshed clipped Limousin. Close to at 158ppk were Messrs DH & SM Churchill, South Chard, with another similar Limousin, who also sold another at 150ppk. Other notable heifer prices were received by Mr MR Nicholls, Wedmore, who sold quality red Limousins at 154ppk twice; Messrs JEF & KF Stephens, Crediton, who sold well fleshed smart Limousins at 150 (x2) and 149.5ppk and Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son, Ottery St Mary, who sold a good Gelbvieh at 149.5ppk. Generally not so much quality amongst the steers, yet a shapely well fleshed Limousin steer from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son again, topped at 160ppk, with a similar

Gelbvieh from the same farm at 148.5ppk. Messrs JEF & KF Stephens also scored with Limousin steers at 158.5, 151.5 and 149ppk. Mr J Baker also offered a shapely, clipped, well fleshed Limousin steer at 149.4ppk. Better shape steers generally around 150ppk, good shape 140-145ppk. Straight sided types 135ppk. Heifers similar and a shade better, reflecting the generally improved fleshing. Overage cattle very keenly sought to 145ppk for a smart Limousin steers from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son again. Heifers to 141ppk for a good Blonde from Messrs Day & Son again. Steers sold to £1088.11 for a grand 809kg Charolais from Messrs Sargent & Son, Sidmouth, who sold another 863kg at £1083.07. Another outstanding run from Messrs DJ & CM Mitchem, Beercrocombe, realised £1086.61, £1081.92, £1064 and £1054.18, all Charolais, with a Limousin from the same farm at £1052.28. Overage steers also close to £1050 at £1046.06 for a good Simmental steer from Messrs CL, AE & RC Sweet, Burtle. Heifers over £1050 at £1052.28 for a shapely, well fleshed Charolais from Messrs Day & Son again, who also sold a Limousin at £972.20. Several heifers over £900 from Messrs DH & SM Churchill again at £963, Limousin; Mr MR Nicholls again at £954.80, Limousin; Messrs Day & Son again at £947.52, Limousin; Messrs RJS Winslade & Son, Moorland, at £940.98 Charolais and Messrs JR, LM & AJ Hutchings, Bridport, at £920.58 with a Charolais. Young bulls to £761.75 and £687.50 for red Limousins from Mr R Coate, Broomfield. Generally a good show of cattle, yet many steers too lean (1 & 2) and some heifers too fat (4H & 5L). Selection is critical and we remind Vendors to keep an eye on ages and finish levels to ensure steers do not run out of time and heifers do not "run too fat". May we thank Vendors for their continued support and hopefully together we can look forward to a favourable Christmas trade.
