#### **Auctioneers Comments:**

A tight entry, 60 back on last week's, met another further improved trade, when steers and heifers were both 4ppk up again on the week. Additional buyers around the ring again in search of supply. Bring your cattle to market for best prices. Open market competition pushes the trade up and markets are the best vehicle to expose that open market demand.

Top of the day was 171ppk for a red Limousin steer, right out of the top drawer from Mr AR Henson, who sold others similar at 170ppk, 167ppk (x2), 166ppk and 163.5ppk. A well fleshed Limousin from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son achieved 167.5ppk, who sold another at 162ppk. A quality run from Messrs AJ Hepper & Son rose to 165.5ppk, with another at 164ppk. Messrs DJ & CM Mitchem also got amongst the highlights at 162.5ppk with a smart Limousin. Better steers generally high 150ppk's. Many good steers 150ppk plus. Straight sided types mid 140ppk's. Prices of note were 135.5ppk, 134.5ppk, 134ppk and 132.5ppk for well finished black & white steers from Mr WG Down. Another, this time from Messrs EJ Wyatt & Sons, similarly well finished also achieved 135ppk.

Steers sold to £1254.17 for a red Limousin from Mr AR Henson, who sold others at £1246.10, £1176.48, £1173.48, £1162 and £1128.15. Another over £1200 at £1243.20 was a grand 888kg Charolais from

Messrs DJ & CM Mitchem. Many others over £1100, which is encouraging as the trade gets back towards what was last year's peak.

Heifers also close to the 170ppk barrier at 169ppk for a shapely Blue from Mr FWV Stone. Other quality heifers at 168ppk, Limousin, from Messrs FR & MJ Morrish; 168ppk again, Limousin, Mr JPT Scott; 166ppk, Limousin, Mr BW Cross; 166ppk again, Limousin, Mr BA Richards; 165ppk, Charolais, Mr S Broom and 164ppk, Limousin, Messrs HC Derryman & Sons. Better heifers also high 150's and good heifers similarly 150ppk plus. Straight sided heifers mid 140's.

Heifers sold to £1054.17 for a well fleshed 663kg Blue from Mr BW Cross. Others over £1000 at £1041.54, Charolais, Mr RG Speed; £1039.50, Charolais, Messrs RJS Winslade & Son; £1017.57, Charolais, Mr S Broom and the best of a smart run of black Limousins from Messrs CE & BD Bailey achieved £1005.41, £1004.72 and £1001.52. Many, many others £900 plus. Overage clean also over £1000 to £1057.88 for a Simmental steer from Messrs F & M House & Son, who sold another £1018.88. Heifers sold to £1014.70 for a Blue from Mr S Broom, which was bid to 146ppk. A smart run of Limousins rose to 148, 146.5, 145.5 and 142ppk for steers and 142.5ppk for a heifer, all from Messrs HWC & JM Butler. As a fore runner to next week's South West Winter Fair, Yarcombe Young Farmers held their annual show and sale. Champion, best presented and winner of the first time exhibitor class, was Lyle Burrough, whose 575kg, 21m, Blue heifer went onto achieve 159.5ppk. Winner of the previous exhibitor class and reserve champion was Duncan Broom, whose 501kg, 21m, Blue heifer achieved 158.5ppk. Full results listed below. Well Done Yarcombe Young Farms for what was a very even and well presented show of 12 Blue heifers.
