Auctioneers Comments:

A very tight entry of under 30 month prime was boosted by the largest entry of the year of over 30 month cattle. An excellent show of cattle, met a further improved trade, dramatically up after last week's initial lift. Some superb cattle on show, with some presented in excellent condition, clipped for sale and with hardly an over fat animal on offer. Selection this week was much better. Still several cattle very plain reflecting the season we've just experienced but with a selection of professional feeders around the ring, lacking finish is a lesser evil compared to cattle being presented over fat. Top of the day was 168ppk for a quality purebred Limousin from Mr MR Nicholls, who sold another top drawer Limousin heifer at 166ppk. Another top Limousin heifer from Messrs AC & CF Heal achieved 164ppk. Better heifers at 156.5ppk, shapely Blue from Mr MT Westaway; 155.5ppk, lightweight Simmental, Mr MJ Jenkins and 154ppk twice, well fleshed strong Charolais from Mr G Vining. Many good heifers 150ppk plus. R grade heifers averaged 147.5ppk, 3.5ppk up on the week. Straighter sided heifers 140ppk plus. All heifers averaged 144.5ppk reflecting the high standard forward and the improvement in the trade. Steers also very keenly sought to 164.5ppk for an exceptional red Limousin from Mr AR Henson, who sold another similar at 159.5ppk, with others 157.5ppk twice. Another best "clean" type red Limousin, this time from Messrs DJ & CM Mitchem achieved 163ppk, who also sold a heavyweight Limousin at 157.5ppk. 162ppk was bid for a quality lightweight Limousin from Messrs HWC & JM Butler. The best of smart runs from

Messrs JR, LM & AJ Hutchings rose to 159.5ppk, Limousin; from Messrs DH & SM Churchill to 158.5ppk, Limousin and from Messrs RJS Winslade & Son to 156.5ppk twice, Charolais and Limousin. Better steers also over 150ppk. R grade also averaged 147.5ppk, up 4.5ppk on the week. Straight sided steers higher 130's. Over 30 month cattle likewise improved to 145ppk twice for good Limousin steers and heifer from Messrs HWC & JM Butler. Better average generally 140ppk plus. Steers sold to £1173.92 for a tremendous 736kg Limousin from Mr AR Henson, who sold others at £1153.15, £1127.70 and £1121.40. More steers over £1100 at £1153.68, £1136.11 and £1134 for grand Limousins from Messrs DJ & CM Mitchem. Another outstanding Limousin steer, 820kg from Mr RHJ Coate at £1107.00. Many others £1000 plus, including an average Blue steer at £1051.35 from Messrs CL, AE & RC Sweet. Heifers also over £1000 at £1083.23, Charolais from Messrs RJS Winslade & Son; £1059.52, Charolais from Mr G Vining and £1005.43, Limousin from Messrs JR, LM & AJ Hutchings. Many £900 plus. An excellent entry of cattle overall for which we thank all Vendors. We now start the count down to the South West Winter Show, which being the last major show of the year is building towards being the grand final of the showing season, with good entries coming forward from throughout the Country. Entry is free to the show and Greenslade Taylor Hunt and the Show Society cordially invite all supporters and friends of Sedgemoor to the show, for what is looking like a real celebration of beef and sheep.
