PLEASE ENSURE ALL CATTLE EAR TAGS HAVE THE FRONT AND BACK OF EACH TAG AS NECESSARY. TRADING STANDARDS WILL SEND HOME CATTLE WITH 1 OR 1½ EAR TAGS.

The biggest entry of the year met an improved trade, with additional buyers in attendance to compete with the regular array. Top of the day was 106ppk for a red Limousin from Messrs J & K Barnard Farms Ltd, who also sold a Charolais at 103.5ppk and a blue Limousin at 103ppk. A young Limousin from Mr DA Small achieved 100ppk. A shortage of meat cows, when plain sucklers were generally 90ppk plus. Feeding sucklers also 90ppk plus. Sucklers sold to £805.20 for an Angus from Messrs MR & SK Westcott, who sold another at £778.32. Stronger sucklers over £750 at £768.18 (Blonde), £765.90 (Charolais) and £752.60 (Limousin) all from Messrs J & K Barnard Farms Ltd. Black and whites peaked at 102.5ppk for a young cow from Messrs Colgrove Partnership of Mevagissey, who sold another at 99ppk and a heifer at 101ppk. Other young cows to 95ppk from Messrs DJ Hill & Partners and 94ppk from Mr MJ House. Older cows also sold to 102.5ppk for a grand 855kg type from Messrs J, EM & NJ Phillips. Better meat cows generally 90ppk plus. Meat with belly or udder waste 85ppk. Steakers 70 to 80ppk. Plain cows at lower levels depending how plain, however the very plainest 10ppk up on week. Black and white heifers sold to 101.5ppk from Messrs R Puddy & Son. Black and whites sold to £876.38 for the grand 855kg cow from Messrs J, EM & NJ Phillips. A stronger 866kg cow from Messrs CG & WL Rich & Son achieved £827.03. Other good cows over £750 at £777.04 from Messrs RP Tucker & Son and £755.13 from Messrs RB Bowditch & Son. Good cows over £700. Heifers sold to £781.55 from Messrs R Puddy & Son. Old stock bulls rose to £915.71 for a tremendous Charolais from Mr C Chilcott. Despite rumours of abattoirs being unable to take cows, even with the large entry, more could have been sold to advantage. We thank all Vendors and Hauliers for their continued support, who travelled from as far afield as Mevagissey, St Austell in Cornwall, Wareham in Dorset and Gloucester to once again support Sedgemoor.

To prevent the escape of livestock from the pennage area, please ensure:-

Outer loading bay gates are securely chained to vehicle tailboard gates when unloading or loading stock. **It will be deemed negligence if this is not done.**

Second set of loading bay gates to be secured with chain (cattle) and sliding fastener (sheep) after unloading.

Gates are always to be left in closed position when vacating loading bays.

In the event of an escape raise alarm and ensure entrance and exit gates are closed. Once entrance and exit gates are closed, then proceed to recapture stock.

Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

All cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 require two tags.

Somerset Trading Standards require any such cattle presented at market with less than two tags to be returned home under licence. Please ensure all cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 have a tag in each ear before leaving home. If a tag is lost in transit, please present tag to STS Animal Health representative for onward licence and sale. If you are unable to replace a missing tag due to ill health or health and safety issues and would like to use market facilities, please write to Somerset Trading Standards Service, Animal Health and Welfare, Chelston, Wellington, Somerset, TA21 9HP, fax : 01823 664199 or email: ahw@somerset.gov.uk to request permission.
