A larger entry, yet slightly reduced on last week's, met a very similar trade. A bit more belly on show to amongst the dairy meat cows, which just took the edge off a touch. Top of the day was 146.5ppk for an outstanding Blonde from Messrs GH & MG Barber, which highlights quality will always sell. Another well fleshed Blonde from the same farm achieved 119.5ppk. A good Angus from Mr M Besley rose to 112.5ppk and a smart Limousin from Messrs CF & WE Richens sold well at 112.0ppk. "Clean" types from Messrs AJ Williams & Saunders both met calls of 110.5ppk. Good meat cows 100 to 105ppk. Feeding cows easier around 90ppk as winter arrives. Sucklers sold to £1107.54 for the Blonde from Messrs GH & MG Barber, with another from the same farm at £939.27. Strong cows over £800 at £848.74, Charollais from Mr BM Rogerson and £809.25, Blue from Mr FA Ward. Black and whites sold to 112ppk for a smart, well fleshed heifer from Messrs GG & D Gribble. 111.5ppk was bid for another good heifer from Mr PD Gooding. Other heifers 99 & 97.5ppk from Messrs Garrett Bros. Young well fleshed under 48 month cows from Messrs Holt Farms Ltd rose to 104ppk, with others similar at 99.5ppk from Cole Farming Ltd and Messrs D & P Mead & Co. A young Montbeliarde cross from Mr & Mrs GN Loder achieved 95.5ppk. Older cows peaked at 96ppk for a well fleshed type from Messrs PG & JE Baker. Better cows still over 90ppk at 94.5ppk, Messrs SR Stuckey & Sons; 93.5ppk, Messrs D & P Mead & Co; 92ppk, Messrs IJ & SA Bell & Son, 91.5 and 91ppk, Messrs Holt Farms Ltd again; 90.5ppk, Messrs PG & JE Baker again and 90ppk Messrs DJ Hill & Partners. Meat cows 80ppk plus. Steakers similar levels around 75ppk. Plain cows also similar around 60ppk. A few very plain cows at lower levels. Black and whites sold to £769.14 for a young cow from Cole Farming Ltd. Other strong cows to £694.08, Messrs PG & JE Baker; £687.65, Messrs M & TD Ellis; £684.45, Messrs RF & BA Larcombe; £678.81, Messrs D & P Mead & Co and £677.12, Messrs IJ & SA Bell. Black and white heifers to £749.28 from Mr PD Gooding, with another from the same farm £669.70. £669.76 was received by Messrs GG & D Gribble for their heifer. Old stock bulls to £913.14 for a Charollais from Mr FA Ward. To prevent the escape of livestock from the pannage area, please ensure:-

Outer loading bay gates are securely chained to vehicle tailboard gates when unloading or loading stock. **It will be deemed negligence if this is not done.**

Second set of loading bay gates to be secured with chain (cattle) and sliding fastener (sheep) after unloading.

Gates are always to be left in closed position when vacating loading bays.

In the event of an escape raise alarm and ensure entrance and exit gates are closed. Once entrance and exit gates are closed, then proceed to recapture stock.

Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

All cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 require two tags.

Somerset Trading Standards require any such cattle presented at market with less than two tags to be returned home under licence. Please ensure all cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 have a tag in each ear before leaving home. If a tag is lost in transit, please present tag to STS Animal Health representative for onward licence and sale. If you are unable to replace a missing tag due to ill health or health and safety issues and would like to use market facilities, please write to Somerset Trading Standards Service, Animal Health and Welfare, Chelston, Wellington, Somerset, TA21 9HP, fax : 01823 664199 or email: ahw@somerset.gov.uk to request permission.
