Auctioneers Comments:

An increased entry of 218 prime cattle, with a high proportion of Angus crosses and black and white steers. Many cattle looked "cold" off grass, which just took the edge off the trade. Best at previous levels.

Top was 205ppk twice for both an outstanding, well shaped Simmental heifer from Mr R & Mrs F Barrow & Son and a superb, clean type red Limousin heifer from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son. Another top drawer Simmental heifer from the Barrows achieved 200.5ppk, as did a tremendous 713kg Blue from Mr RG Speed and another clean red Limousin from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son again. Steers also over 200ppk at 204.5ppk for a very smart red Limousin from Mr J Baker. Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Sons also scored on the steer's side with a typical "Woodford Barton" steer at 198.5ppk.

Other very best cattle mid to high 190's. Better types mid 180's. Good steers and heifers mid 170's. More commercial cattle high 160's. Cattle lacking shape around 160ppk. Those lacking shape and flesh at lower levels.

Steers sold to £1,469.70 for a grand 852kg Charolais from Mr TJ Richards, who sold another similar at £1,394.69. Several steers achieved £1300 and above.

Heifers also over £1400 at £1,429.57 for the exceptional Blue from Mr RG Speed. Heifers over £1200 from Mr R & Mrs F Barrow & Son at £1,246.40 (Simmental) and from Mr J, EM & NJ Phillips & Sons at £1,226.25 (Blue). Several heifers £1100 plus.

Overage clean keenly sought to £1,252.08 for a Simmental steer from Mr TP Newton. Heifers peaked at £1,141.91 for a Simmental from Messrs ARE & KA Sparks, who also sold a Charolais heifer at £1,122.52. **Many thanks to all Vendors alike as it was most pleasing to rise over the 200 head mark again. More cattle kindly requested as we lead up to Christmas.**
