A massive weekly entry of 102 Dairy Cattle forward when 74 milking cows and heifers saw another good trade. 37 of the milkers travelled to 6 different purchasers from North of Bristol and over 70% of the entry travelled out of Somerset. This shows the benefit of the M5 motorway connections.

No real outstanding heifers forward but the best still regularly sold over £1800 to a top of £1970 for Shottle bred heifer from Nick Goss of Devizes. Others to £1920 for Nick Heywood. Messrs JM & BS Jones of Caldicot, Wales saw his 3 heifers achieve £1890, £1810 and £1800. Also £1850 was bid for a pedigree heifer from Messrs FG Summerhayes & Sons. A grand show from John & Heather Snook sold to £1840 and £1750. A pedigree Poundhill bred show heifer to £1800 for Miss A Westwood. Also £1800 for Mr RA Willcox. Cows to £1680 for Mr R Webb and also Mr M Powell. Others to £1540 x 3 for Martin Rowe, Derek Tottle and John Snook.

A smart run of 20 in calf heifers saw a good trade for those due December/January to £1280 x 2 and £1270 Messrs J & G Shire & Son. January to April calvers to £1270 and £1240 for Messrs GP & J Gibbons, Exeter.

Weaned off calves to £380 x 3 for Messrs E & HM Sheldon & Son, Dursley. Young calves to £300 Messrs MP & LM Crudge & Shere.

This week we set a new record store cattle average of £803.91 and that with a show not the size of previous weeks. Never before have store cattle at Sedgemoor been so well sold! 652 head were penned out of a total store cattle and stirk entry of 959. Top was £1300 for a 24m, feeding Angus, with sire details from Messrs EF & MA Cottle, Pitcombe, which was part of the monthly native store cattle sale. Other Angus steers from the same farm at £1202 (25m x 2) and £1135 (24/25m). Grand feeding continental steers from Messrs JC & PA Chapple, Musbury achieved £1290 for 20/21m Simmentals and £1230 for 19m Charolais. Other Charolais steers, being feeders and 23m from Messrs D Wyatt & Son, Axminster sold well at £1230, with others similar (23/24m) at £1220. An exceptionally well grown 15m Limousin steer from Messrs LJ Waygood & Son hit £1225. £1200 was also achieved by Messrs TG Lunt, Hawkchurch with three Charolais steers (18/21m & FA).

Hereford steers with sire details, 25/27m and half meat (x7) from Mr RM & Mrs CG Drew, Buckland St Mary rose to £1150. Devon steers with sire details and growth (25/26m x 10) from Messrs RF Tucker & Son, Glastonbury met a final call of £1130. Steer after steer after steer £1000 plus, including Holsteins from Mr GJ & Mrs ED Porter, overage and fleshed at £1020. Other fleshed Friesians at £940 (23/24m x 5) from Mr & Mrs DH Ashman, Cleeve. Heifers also over £1000 at £1065, 19m Simmental from Mr A Wheeler, Torrington; £1025 for a well finished overage Holstein from Mr RM & Mrs HJ Herrod, Axminster; £1022 for shapely (17/21m & FA) Blues from Messrs House & Son and £1012 for half meat Blues (23/24m & FA) from Mr RM & Mrs HJ Herrod again. Charolais heifers (19m) from Mr A Wheeler again achieved £990, who also sold a 19m Blue at £980, another 19m Simmental at £970 and 19m Limousins at £960. Messrs RF Tucker also scored with heifers, Devons again at £985 (25/26m, FA and fleshed) with others similar (24/27m x 8) at £920. Another over £950 was a 29m Charolais from Mr CD White, Cleeve at £955.

Angus heifers also in the vanguard at £945 (23m) from Messrs EF & MA Cottle again, with others at £935 (24/26m) from Messrs AG Chaplin & Sons, Langford.

Other young stores to £1045 for four pure 15m Simmental steers from Messrs N & KA Williams, Langport. A 17m South Devon bull from Messrs PG Bowditch, Hawkchurch rose to £905. 16m Charolais steers from Messrs CG & JM Heard, Umberleigh sold well at £880. The best of a good run from MR PA Cleave, Bude peaked at £910 for a 13m Charolais steer. Another 12m at £875 and a Limousin, 9m at £870. 15/16m Charolais heifers from Messrs J & B Pincombe, Nomansland also sold well at £842.

Very few Farm Assured cattle on offer, which was acceptable as most were under 26m, when a generally younger show of cattle were on offer. Please remember though that Farm Assurance does make a difference for cattle over 26m.

A high quality entry of 30 beef cross calves met an extremely keen trade all day. Buyers from mid Wales, Essex and Norfolk added to the strong West Country complement to ensure strong bidding throughout. Averages up across the board when 80 calves sold at £300 or above, led by a cracking Blue from Messrs MW Nash & Partners at £428. Charolais to £425 Messrs DJ & SE Bristol; Simmentals £398; Limousins £386 Mr EM Voizey. Other Blues £374, £370 and many strong continental x bulls over £350 and most £280-£350, with medium bulls to around £250 and small bulls £150 plus.
