After last week's wonderful trade, it was staggering that this week's was just as good, if not better. A tremendous show of stirks and busk calves. Top of the day was £710 for an exceptional "E+" British Blue steer from Messrs EJ & JD Cope, who sold other similar types at £705 (7m), £695 twice (6m & 7m) and £675 (6m).

An outstanding run in anyone's estimation. Well grown 7m Charolais busk calves from Mr J Garland sold exceptionally well at £685, £680 twice and £635. A 6m quality British Blue busk calf from Messrs S & S Fraser rose to £675 also. Well bred 7m Blonde steers from Mrs ME Sheppard achieved £670, with a 5m similar type at £535 from the same farm. A tremendous run of Limousin cross busk calves from Mr SC French peaked at £668 twice (7m), with others from the same farm £665 (7/8m), £640 (9m), £600 twice and £625. A credit to Sidney & Guy. The best from Messrs M Harrison Partners peaked at £650 (6m Charolais and Simmental steers). A strong 10m Simmental steer from Messrs N & KA Williams sold well at £638. The best of a shapely run of British Blue busk calves from Mr M Naish rose to £610 (5/6m), with others from the same farm £590 twice and a Charolais (6m) also from Mr M Naish at £610. £610 was also achieved by Messrs Habberfield & Priscott with a smart 7m Limousin steer. Many, many other good continental busk calves £570 plus. Native steers peaked at £592 for a yearling Devon from Mr TVD Eames. Heifers topped at £595 for a super 7m Blonde from Mrs ME Sheppard. Good Limousin busk calves from Mr SC French rose to £540 (8m), £532 (7m), with others high £400s. A well fleshed yearling Shorthorn from Messrs S & J Willis achieved £540, with another £480. Other heifers over £500 at £520 (7m) Limousin from Messrs Habberfield & Priscott; £505 (8m) Aberdeen Angus from Mr SJ Taylor; £502 (10m) Simmental from Messrs N & KA Williams and £500 for an 11m Simmental from Mr RN Darch and 5m British Blues from Mr M Naish. A superb show of stirks for which vendors have to be congratulated. 40 purchasers again. Many thanks to all.
