A slightly reduced entry in terms of numbers, met an exceptional trade for the best. Top price of the day was £750 for a superbly shaped British Blue cross Blonde steer (8m) from Mr EJ & Mrs JD Cope. Quality 10m Charolais steers from Mr WC Fewings achieved £675. A tremendous run of Aberdeen Angus steers out of South Devon cows from Messrs DW & JK Calton of Yelverton rose to £660 (10m); £650 (10m) and £645 (10m). Good Limousins (10/11m) from Mr MJ Grinter returned at £640. Other better steers, again over £600, achieved £615 for Messrs J & M Luscombe of South Brent, being 10-12m Simmentals. Simmentals also stronger with 10 over £300 to £355 from Messrs H & NM Wall. Others £352 Messrs Habberfield Bros, £346, £330. Top Limousins also at £330, £320 and Charolais to £364 (out of MRI) from Mr & Mrs Loder, also £356, £349, £340. Good interest in quality heifers. Blues at the head to £352 for an exceptional Blue heifer from Messrs TE Pocock & Co, Stringston. Also £308 Messrs DW Rowe & Son, £300 Messrs Spiller. Good Limousins and Simmentals to £250 and plenty of smart heifers over £220. Medium heifers £160-£200. Limousins looked a decent buy. Best native heifers to £155 today only young calves forward.
