Auctioneers Comments:

A slightly reduced entry, yet still very tight for the time of year, which met a much improved trade with all abattoirs firing to secure stock. Top of the day was 161.5ppk for a quality red Limousin from Messrs PA Strawbridge. Smart Limousin steers from Messrs AJ Hepper & Son achieved 158.5, 157.0 and 152ppk. A run of well bred suckler types from Messrs JEF & KF Stephens also sold well at 158.5 (twice) and 151.5ppk twice. The weekly consignment from Messrs RJS Winslade & Son peaked at 153ppk for a Charolais suckler bred steer. A good black Limousin steer from Messrs FG Payne & Sons also broke the 150ppk mark at 150.5ppk. Good steers generally higher 140's. Straighter sided types higher 130's. Several lesser types also well into the 130's, reflecting the strength of the trade. Steers sold to £1070.51 for a well fleshed Blue from Messrs SJ & RW Staples. Other grand steers over £1000 came forward from Mr RHJ Coate, being Black Limousins at £1057.60 and £1038.80; Mr RW Mitchell, Simmental at £1016.40 and Mr RR Cheriton, Charolais at £1014.14. Heifers were a ripping trade, reflecting the overall better fleshing which was on offer. Heifers also over 160ppk to 161ppk for a continuation of the run from Messrs JEF & KF Stephens, who sold another smart heifer at 155ppk.

A well fleshed shapely Limousin from Messrs F & M House & Son achieved 159ppk. The best of a long run of heifers from Mr MT Westaway peaked at 157ppk. Messrs FG Payne & Sons scored again, this time with a black Limousin heifer at 156ppk. A quality lean red Limousin from Messrs PA Strawbridge again achieved 155.5ppk. Better heifers generally over 150ppk. Good heifers also high 140's. Straighter sided types around 140ppk and some lesser types also high 130's. Heifers sold to £1006.14 for a strong Charolais from Mr G Vining, who sold another at £974.74. A well fleshed Blonde from Messrs MB & KN Crabb achieved £966.96. Another over £950 was a Blue from Messrs MD & GJ Curtis at £951.20. Overage clean also an improved trade to £1123.40 for a Blue steer from Messrs CL, AE & RC Sweet, who sold another at £1064.74. Strong Simmental steers from the same farm £969, £949 and £942.31. Overage heifers to £946.08 for a smart Limousin from Messrs GW & GM Long & Son, which sold at 144ppk. 144ppk was also bid for a good overage Limousin heifer from Messrs F & M House & Son. Young bulls to 147ppk for a pure bred Simmental from Mr RN Darch, with another, this time from Miss L Darch at £950.76. Trade is on the up again as finished cattle would appear to be in tight supply.
