Other quality Limousin steers from Messrs DJ & CM Mitchem at 159.5ppk and 156.5ppk. Other better steers 150ppk plus. Good steers 140ppk plus. Straighter sided types mid 130's.

Some top drawer heifers were on show at 159ppk, Limousin, Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son; 159ppk, Limousin, Messrs Day & Son; 158.5ppk, Limousin, Mr J Baker; 158.5ppk and 156ppk, Limousin, Mr R Coate and 157ppk, Limousin, Messrs JR & EA Roberts.

Best heifers again 150ppk plus. Good heifers around and above 140ppk and straighter sided heifers also mid 130's.

Steers sold to £1,138.76 for a tremendous 853kg Charolais from Messrs DJ & CM Mitchem, who sold others £1,108.96, 863kg Charolais; £1,100.40, 786kg Charolais; £1,090.98, 684kg Limousin; £1,079.85, 690kg Limousin; £1,053.00, 810kg, Simmental; £1,050.88, 821kg Simmental and £1,043.92, 743kg Simmental. A tremendous achievement in any assessment. Just preventing the Mitchems making a clean sweep of the top 10 were Messrs RJS Winslade & Son with Lot 1, a grand 862kg Charolais at £1,103.36.

Other heifers over £900 at £925.58 for a well fleshed Gelbvieh from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son, who sold another at £922.71; £925.38, Limousin Messrs MD & GJ Curtis; £907.46, Limousin, Messrs C Tripp & Son; £906.66, Charolais, Mr S Broom and £904.75, Limousin, Mr JM Cload.
