Testimony to the quality of ewes on show, buyers were drawn from Northern Ireland, West Yorkshire, Pembrokeshire, Powys, Herefordshire, Worcestershire and Shrewsbury. In addition to buyers from across the water and the North, strong contingencies were present from Devon and Cornwall, as well as Somerset itself.

This year's prestigious event was led by the dispersal of Messrs JTG & EG Sleep's in lamb ewes and shearling ewes from their Trevadlock Flock XAA, the real cream of the South West. She boasts true depth of breeding, her grandsire on the dam's side being Carnevas Ascender, a ram renown for producing superb rams and females alike, who was by the famous Highway Mr Softie. She scanned a single by Foulrice Informer. This flashy ewe sold to Mr A Davies of Llandeilo.

The second ewe to set the bidding alight at 1800gns was secured by Mr RJ Tindall of West Yorkshire. XAA8239 a 2007 born is a real eye-catcher. Scanned a single, first class and correct she is sired by the famous Foxhill Farm Gremlin bred by Messrs M & M Alford of Cullompton. With Casteallau, Lowerye, Blythe and Bould all in her pedigree, this ewe promises a bright future in the show ring.

Striding ahead at 1050gns was a smart 2008 born ewe XAA9034, scanned with twins and again by Gremlin and out of a much admired ewe from Dalby bloodlines, she found her home with Messrs Morgan & Co of Hereford for 1050gns.

Shining through at 1000gns was another 2008 born ewe XAA9047 scanned with twins, who also found her home with Messrs Morgan & Co by Tredethy Great Boy, a ram of outstanding gigot, loin and width who has produced numerous prize winners and has been shown himself with much success including Championship and Interbreed titles.

XAA8208 also came to the fore and sold at 1000gns Mr RA Owen of Powys. A 2008 born ewe, again by the renown Shipley Debonair, her rich breeding carries Penywern Bond, the sire of numerous Gold Award Winners and Foulrice Rival bred by Mr C Marwood.

Another stunner from Messrs Sleep sold again to Mr Tindall from West Yorkshire to 1000gns. A Rockvilla Globe Trotter daughter, she boasts the Logie Durno, Rutland and Foulrice prefixes. She has a history of top prices behind her.

A firm supporter of the Sedgemoor sales, Mrs Louise Brewer of the Carnevas Flock - YHM, found her usual favoured trade, when her top ewe sold to 720gns. By Parkgate Honoured Guest, this smart ewe had all attention on her as the hammer fell to Mr P Tully, Bridgwater.
