A reduced entry met a firmer trade, when some good bunches of feeding cattle were keenly sought.

Top of the day was £910 for a good run of Charolais (25m) from Mr LR Cox, Langport, who sold others at £870. £872 was achieved by Mr J Duncan, Winsham, with a very smart 19m South Devon. A big run of cattle was crowned by a bunch of 25m Blues from Mr DP Kiff, Barnstaple, at £870, whose 25m Limousins sold well at £830, also Charolais at £800. A strong 26m Charolais steer from Mr NR Huxter, Bridport rose to £862, with others at £800. A run of overage Charolais from Messrs E & S Fewings, South Molton, topped at £860, with others at £805 and a 23m Charolais from the same farm at £842. Messrs DG & RH Matravers', Taunton, run of steers peaked at £848 for a 25m Blue, with 23/25m Simmentals at £830 and £825 and £800 for a 25m Hereford steer. Natives rose to £840 for a 23m Angus with sire details from Mr EM Burrigge, West Buckland. Others £790, 24m, Angus from Mr GD Dyke, Wells.

Black and white steers topped at £670 (overage) from Messrs AS Poultney & Sons, Bleadney. Others at £635(26/27m) from Messrs RW Rich & GA Jarrett, Tiverton.

Heifers sold to a top of £792 for a well fleshed 29m Limousin from Messrs EJ Collin & Son, Chard, who also Charolais (27m) at £745 and £730. Smart farm assured Limousin heifers (25/26m) from Messrs HC Derryman & Son, Stockland, sold well at £770. £742 was bid for a 26m Charolais from Mr P Wall, Somerton. Forward 16/17m Charolais from Mr TG Lunt, Hawkchurch, sold well at £732. Four smart 23/26m Simmental heifers from Mr G Carbin achieved £725. Native heifers peaked at £625 for 28m South Devons from Messrs GH & PC Dening, Yeovil.

Young stores sold to £805 for a 16m Charolais steer from Mr SD Heal, Stathe. A good run of continental steers, 12 to 16m, from Messrs KC & JC Heard, Okehampton topped at £780, with others at £770 and £735, with heifers from the same farm at £635. 16m Limousin steers at £780 and £745 from Messrs RWJ Hayman, Cullompton. 15m Blonde steers from Mr TG Lunt again sold at £745. 16m Limousin steer at £722 from Mr H Leyshon, Neath, West Glamorgan. Young heifers, 16/17m, being quality red Limousins from Messrs W & S Cobden, achieved £632.

With additional buyers from Norfolk and Cambridge, trade was much better than might have been expected. We might not see a big Autumn flush this year, which will help to hold the trade at current levels.
