A much larger entry as a direct result of the change in the weather, met a trade which on paper looked easier but when the reduced general level of quality on offer is taken into account, trade was not so much down with the best little affected. Sucklers sold in excess of last week, to 117.5ppk for a smart South Devon from Mr RJ Maltby. A tremendous pedigree Simmental from Mr DB Mills rose to 109ppk. Other better sucklers at 108.5ppk for a Limousin from Mr PFJ Saunders, 106.5ppk for a Limousin from Mr DF Rawlins and a shapely Angus at 104.5ppk from Messrs RC Loosmore & Son. Good meat sucklers around 100ppk. Several fat sucklers 90 to 95ppk, unless exceptionally over covered. Feeding sucklers more varied with quality, yet good feeders still 90ppk plus. Sucklers sold to £1026.78 for the ex-show cow, Simmental, from Mr DB Mills. A strong Bazadais from Messrs Cubitt-Gillard Partners achieved £902.47. Another over £800 was a Charolais from Mr PFJ Saunders at £813.75. Many others still £700 plus. Black and whites cows, as per last week, rose to 99.5ppk for an MRI from Messrs JV & MJ Pidgeon. Other best meat cows to 97 and 96.5ppk from Messrs CE Marks & Sons; 96.5ppk also from Messrs FE Hill & Son and 95ppk Messrs RF & BA Larcombe. Better meat cows still generally 90ppk plus. Meat with belly again 85ppk. Steakers easier around 75ppk and the bottom end much lower than of late around 60ppk, reflecting the increased show of plain cows, 72 against 32 last week and how generally the colder weather has had an effect on their general condition with some very plain cows forward. Black and white cows sold to £822.50 for a grand 875kg Holstein from Messrs Milton & Thorne. Other grand cows well over £750 at £791.52, Messrs CE Marks & Son; £779.72, Messrs FE Hill & Son; £775.20, Messrs RF & BA Larcombe and £770.18 from Cole Farming Ltd. Many cows still well over £700. Bulls sold to 86.5ppk and £974.86 for a well fleshed, outstanding 1127kg Holstein from Mr DJ Huxtable. A run of very lean overage Montbeliarde steers from Messrs Lordwood Farms Ltd, met very keen demand up to 125.5ppk twice, with others 124 (twice), 123.5 and 123ppk. These returned from £600 to £666.90. Trade still very good for the time of year and once the housing flush is passed, which we expect to be short lived, we anticipate the bottom end will soon bounce back up to former levels.

 Gates are always to be left in closed position when vacating loading bays.
 In the event of an escape raise alarm and ensure entrance and exit gates are closed. Once entrance and exit gates are closed, then proceed to recapture stock.
 Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

All cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 require two tags.

Somerset Trading Standards require any such cattle presented at market with less than two tags to be returned home under licence. Please ensure all cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 have a tag in each ear before leaving home. If a tag is lost in transit, please present tag to STS Animal Health representative for onward licence and sale.
