A much larger entry, yet still another good trade. There might not be the anticipated annual Autumn flush this year, as at the time of writing, despite heavy rains last week, cows are still out and numbers remain relatively tight as a consequence, which in turn holds the trade up. Sucklers topped at 118.5ppk for a young Hereford from Messrs J & W Welland. A smart Blonde from Messrs RG Griffin & Son achieved 117ppk. Better sucklers 110ppk plus. Good meat cows 100ppk plus. Feeding cows again up to 100ppk. Sucklers sold to £906.26 for a strong 802kg Blue from Messrs McEwen Smith. Others £823.62, Blonde, Mr A Cleave; £789.25, Angus, Messrs A & I Peppard, when many others were £700 plus. Black and whites peaked at 113.5ppk for a heifer from Messrs MB & CJN Ayre, when another heifer achieved 109ppk from Childhay Organic Dairy. Young cows rose to 107.5ppk from Messrs PG & JE Baker, when another from Messrs AJ Gay & Son Ltd achieved 105.5ppk. Older cows rose to 106ppk for an MRI from Messrs MR & P Cooke. Best Black and whites 100ppk plus at 103.5ppk, Messrs AJ Gay & Son Ltd and 103ppk, Messrs PG & JE Baker. Better cows 95 to 99.5ppk. Good cows up and down of 90ppk. Half meat cows 85ppk. Steakers 80 to 90ppk dependant on waste and with the plainer grade 4's at lower levels looked the dearest sold. Bags of bones 65ppk, which in a flush could be 40ppk. Black and whites sold to £847.08 for a tremendous 936kg cow from Messrs AW Hewlett & Son. Another over £800 at £807.70 came forward from Messrs RJ & EM Puddy. Again several over £700 with many in the high £600's. Black and white heifers to £802.43 from Messrs GW & GM Long & Son, when another from Childhay Organic Dairy achieved £790.25. Bulls sold to £1012.05 for a South Devon from Messrs RJ Rew & Sons, when a Charolais from Mr DM Ruell Achieved £1003.44.

To prevent the escape of livestock from the pannage area, please ensure:-

Outer loading bay gates are securely chained to vehicle tailboard gates when unloading or loading stock. **It will be deemed negligence if this is not done.**

Second set of loading bay gates to be secured with chain (cattle) and sliding fastener (sheep) after unloading.

Gates are always to be left in closed position when vacating loading bays.

In the event of an escape raise alarm and ensure entrance and exit gates are closed. Once entrance and exit gates are closed, then proceed to recapture stock.

Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

All cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 require two tags.

Somerset Trading Standards require any such cattle presented at market with less than two tags to be returned home under licence. Please ensure all cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 have a tag in each ear before leaving home. If a tag is lost in transit, please present tag to STS Animal Health representative for onward licence and sale. If you are unable to replace a missing tag due to ill health or health and safety issues and would like to use market facilities, please write to Somerset Trading Standards Service, Animal Health and Welfare, Chelston, Wellington, Somerset, TA21 9HP, fax : 01823 664199 or email: ahw@somerset.gov.uk to request permission. Copy of written confirmation of STSS's permission to accompany stock to market with tags and taggers.
