**Auctioneers Comments:**

A tight entry of 162 prime cattle on an unseasonably beautiful day. Following on from the stores on Saturday, prime cattle were in short supply and trade was noticeably brighter.

Some improved quality cattle forward to 203ppk twice for a top drawer Limousin steer from Messrs CG & EM Baker and a similar heifer from Mr S Broom. Other best cattle over 200ppk included a Limousin heifer from Messrs DH & SM Churchill at 202ppk; a Limousin steer from Mr KJ & Mrs S Bishop at 201ppk; a Blonde steer from Brightley Farms and a Limousin heifer from Mr J Baker, both at 200.5ppk and a Limousin heifer from Mr AL Hobbs at 200ppk.

Very best shapely cattle generally around 200ppk. Better cattle 180ppk plus. Good types mid 170's, others mid to high 160's.

A price of note was a proper Friesian from Messrs RH Groves & Sons at 167ppk.

Young bulls to 172ppk for a well fleshed 13m Hereford from Mr JP Stone. Overage cattle little different to underage up to 179.5ppk for a Blue steer from Messrs DB Hawkins & Son.

Steers sold to £1,352 for a grand 800kg Angus from Mr DF Boyland. Another over £1300 was a Limousin steer from Messrs W Johnson & Son at £1,304.94.

Heifers rose to £1,265.57 for a well fleshed 709kg Limousin from Messrs I Forbes & Son. Another over £1200 was a shapely Limousin from Messrs DH & SM Churchill at £1,248.36.

It is probably too early to say whether the trade is on the up again, however the good weather has given it a fillip, as a result of supply tightening, future rises are expected as we approach Christmas. **More cattle kindly requested.**
