A tight entry of 673 store cattle on a beautiful October's morning, met probably the best trade ever seen for strong cattle. 10 cattle sold over £1200 to £1270 for a strong, feeding, farm assured Limousin steer (27m) from Mr THJ Denbee, Wedmore. A bunch of 5 forward, feeding (FA) Blue steers (21/24m) from Messrs FE Hill & Son, Fiddington, sold well at £1250. Strong, lean Blonde steers (28m) from Mr RM Prowse, Exeter rose to £1230, as did a fleshed Angus steer (24m) from Messrs CE Marks & Sons, Hatch Beauchamp. Another at £1200 was the best of a run of steers, being a Charolais, FA and 24m from Mr D Matravers. 18 other big steers over £1100, with another 26 over £1000.

Other native steers sold to £982 for a 28m Hereford from Mr RGJ & Mrs D Thomson.

Black and white steers also close to four figures at £995 for a 22m FA Friesian from Messrs AS Poultney & Sons, Bleadney, with others (FA and 23m) at £955 from Messrs J & A Moon, Glastonbury and £940 (FA and 22/26m) from Messrs RA Wilkins & Sons, Henley.

Heifers also over four figures at £1070 for a shapely Charolais (22m) from Mr M & Mrs M Alford, Blackborough. Another over £1000 at £1025 was a smart 19m Charolais from Mr JG Warfield, Limington. £1010 was bid for a bunch of 8 fleshed Blue heifers (19/24m and FA) from Messrs FE Hill & Son again, who sold others leaner (19/21m) at £952. £990 was bid for strong Limousins (19/21m) from Mr RJ Wheeler, Westbury Sub Mendip. Other continental heifers over £950 came forward from Mr CRG Wall, East Huntspill at £965, Limousin overage; Messrs Ponsillo & Son, Burtle at £955, Blue (23m) and Mr JG Warfield again at £955 again, Charolais (20m).

Native heifers peaked at £980 for an overage Hereford from Mr RGJ & Mrs D Thompson again, who also sold an overage Angus at £935. Angus heifers (22m) topped at £945 from Mr CE Marks & Sons, again, with others at £930 (23m) from Mr S Broom, Crewkerne.

Young stores peaked at £910 for 16m Limousin steers from Mr KJ Seymour, Blackford, who sold others 16m at £870 and another 15m at £820. 16m Simmental steers from Mr T Williams, Felton achieved £865, with a Limousin steer, 14m at £830. £850 was bid for a Blue bull (16m) from Messrs CWM & GN Bolt, Huntsham. Well bred 7/8m Charolais bulls from Mr J Wylde, Bridgwater sold particularly well at £835. Young heifers also over £800 at £810 for a 15m Limousin from Mr KJ Seymour again.

A lighter entry of 217 beef calves, not quite the quality of recent weeks but strong calves at a premium. Top price £442 for a 12 week Simmental from Messrs Harry. Limousins off cows to £405 Mr N Pollett. Other Blues £380 and Simmentals to £373 Mr D Ham. Superb young Limousins from Messrs CS & JM Petheram to a tremendous £364.

Most good continental bulls £280 plus with second quality sorts, especially Blues in the £230-£270 range. A bright heifer trade across the board saw Charolais to £316, Limousin £310 and £280. A lot of Blues £220-£250 at the higher end and topped at £262 Messrs DJ & SL Kittow. Medium heifers £170-£200, smaller heifers at £120 plus. Tremendous call for the native breeds saw Hereford bulls to £230 Messrs AW & AJ Crabb. Others £220 and heifers extremely sharp to £210 Mr WE Turner & Son.
