A much reduced entry of 594 store cattle on one of the hottest days of the year, as Vendors catch late grass and finish any harvest.

Trade still hot for fleshed cattle and quality. Generally a very variable show and some secondary types not as fast as of late.

Top of the day was £1320 for a tremendous, well fleshed, Farm Assured 27m Blue steer from Messrs EJ Collins & Son, Chard, who had other outstanding Farm Assured steers at £1280, Charolais (28m) £1110, Friesian (31m) £1100, Simmental (28m) and £1090, Limousin (26m). A monumental Charolais (29m) from Messrs RS & EA Slape, Chittlehampton, achieved £1300, with others £1120 (25m x 4); £1100 (29m) and £1070 (25m x 4). Another strong, farm assured run from Messrs DW & AE Enticott, Ashbrittle sold well at £1155, Simmentals (18/24m) £1145, Charolais (20/24m x 5) and £1060, Charolais (22/23m). Well fleshed steers from Mr J Hannam, Street at £1150, Blue (27m) with others £1090, Simmentals (24/25m x 6) and £1025, Simmentals (25m). Other Simmentals at £1095 (18m)

Messrs JC & PA Chapple, Musbury; £1070 (17/18m) Messrs AC & DM Dyer, Yarcombe; £1050 (27m) and £1030 (29m) Mr J Sherwin, West Buckland and £1045 (18m) Mr RJ Edwards, Pawlett. Other Charolais steers to £1090 (18m) Messrs JC & PA Chapple again. Limousin steers rose to £1085 for two good feeding types (23/24m) and FA from Messrs HC Derryman & Son, Stockland. Others at £1055 (17m) Messrs AC & DM Dyer again. Other Blue steers £1045 twice from both Messrs WD & VJ Masters, Ilchester (26m and FA) and Messrs PT Bale, Lydmars (26m and FA).

Native steers peaked at £1125 (25m) for Angus from Messrs EF & MA Cottle, Bruton, who sold others at £1025 (26m) and £955 (25m). £960 was bid for a 24m FA Angus steer from Messrs NJ & CA Pyle, Ottery St Mary. Others £900 (15/16m) Messrs LF & AJ Bartlett, Gittisham.

Other black and white steers after the £1100 bullock at £880 23/24m and £770 (22/23m) Messrs NJ & CA Pyle again: £770 (27/28m) Mr CJ Chant, Bower Hinton; £762 (17m) Mr CJ White & Partners, Brompton Regis and £700 (22/24m) Messrs WD & VJ Masters again. Friesians in short supply and dearer if anything.

Heifers sold to £1070 for a well fleshed FA Simmental from Messrs EJ Collins & Son again, who also sold a bunch (x5) of Charolais (27/28m) at £1060 and a Limousin (26m) at £1005. Messrs JC & PA Chapple also scored with very shapely Simmental heifers (18/19m) at £1050 and a Charolais (19m) at £930. Mr CJ Chant also featured with Limousin heifers (26/27m and FA) at £1050, with another (26m) at £900.

Half meat Limousin heifers (23/25m) from Messrs HC Derryman & Son again sold well at £1000. Other good Simmental heifers to £970 (18m) Mr RJ Edwards again. Blue heifers to £935 (26m and FA) Messrs IF Ford & Partners and £900 twice for both Messrs LF & AJ Bartlett again (25m and FA) and Messrs EFB Hill & Son, East Bower (25m and FA). Other Charolais heifers at £900 from both Messrs RS & EA Slape again (28m) and Mr J Hannam again (26/27m and FA).

Some good meat Friesian heifers forward at £920 (31m) and £835 (20/25m x 7) Messrs Bridgwater College and £912 (36m) Messrs NJ & CA Pyle again.

Others at £870 for a shapely 16m Angus from Mr AF Palk, Torquay and more South Devon heifers (22/27m and FA) from Messrs BR & MS Pike, Colyton and Hereford heifers also (27/29m) Messrs DF & SA Maynard, Awliscombe.

Young stores rose to £968 for three top drawer red Limousin steers (13m and FA) from Mr & Mrs TH Bolt, Huntsham, who sold others at £950 (13/14m) £870 (13m) and £855 (13m) £900, Angus steers (15/16m) Messrs LF & AJ Bartlett again; £855 (17m) Blue steer, Messrs PG Bowditch & Son; £830 (12m) £825 (11m) £810 (13m) and £790 (12m) all from Mr WJ Bown, Catcott. 16m Hereford steers from Mr NG Biffen, Wellington achieved £825.
