A similar sized entry of 774 store cattle, highlighted again the fact that store cattle numbers are generally tight. A larger overall entry of 1260 store, stirks and sucklers and strong trades all round.

No real big cattle forward to hit former highs but stronger feeding cattle very keenly sought. Top was £1150 twice for smart black Limousin steers (13/21m) from Mr MR Lee, West Buckland, who sold another 25m at £1120 and a strong Simmental steer (29m) from Messrs TR Paul, Merriott. Other good feeding red and white Simmental steers (17/18m) from Messrs RJ Hill & Son, Tavistock hit £1100, with others £1015. Quality Charolais steers (18/19m) from Mr JF Biffen, Wellington rose to £1080, with two other bunches both at £1032. A shapely Limousin steer (19m) from Mr JLD Burrough & Son, Wambrook sold particularly well at £1065. The best of a run from Messrs RA Wilkins & Sons, Henley achieved £1060 for Simmental steers (20/22m). Quality Limousin steers (18/20m) from Mr A Wheeler, Torrington rose to £1055, who sold a Blue steer (18m) at £1050 and a Simmental steer (19m) at £1045. Another at £1050 was a Charolais steer (19m) from Mr FR Butt, Dunkeswell.

Angus steers, part of the special monthly native store cattle sale also over £1100 at £1128 for 17/20m feeders from Mr RJ Wall, Lymsham. Another Angus steer (19m) this time from Mr RA Reed, Seaton sold well at £1090. A Hereford steer (21m) from Messrs RL Jones & Son, Wiveliscombe rose to £1065. Angus steers again (20m) from Messrs A Male & Son, Martock met a call of £1055.

Black and white steers over £1000 at £1010 (29m & FA) from Mr GJ Pincombe, Ilfracombe. Next best was £830 for 20/26m HF from Mr RA Wilkins & Sons again.

Heifers topped at £1052 for well grown 22/24m Simmentals from Mr FR Butt again, who also sold a 25m Charolais at £990, a 22m Blue at £980 and another Simmental (25m) at £950. Well fleshed Simmentals (24/25m) from Messrs DG & SA Cullen, Walton, sold well at £1000. Messrs RJ Hill & Son featured again with Simmental heifers at £978 (17m) £970 (17/18m) and £915 (18m). £975 was achieved by Messrs HK & S Cligg, Musbury with a 28m Simmental heifer, who sold others (20/22m) at £875. Mr JLD Burrough & Son, Wambrook also sold a shapely Limousin heifer (18m) at £950 and Blue heifers at £942 (18m) and £900 (19m). A smart Gelbvieh heifer (28m & FA) from Messrs B & AR Tippetts achieved £945, with an overage Charolais from the same farm at £900. £935 was bid for a forward Simmental heifer (27m) from Mr N Taylor, Ottery. Other heifers over £900 came forward from Mr A Wheeler again at £910 for 18/19m Limousins and at £905 for a 21m Limousin from Mr JG Warfield, Limington.

Quality young stores, being 14/16m Simmentals from Mr BE Hingston, Paignton achieved £960, with others 11 to 14m at £805. A 12m Blonde steer from Messrs NM & CL Norris, Holford sold especially well at £922. 15/16m Simmental steers from Mr D Vigers, Lewdown achieved £908.

Young heifers peaked at £832 for a 13m Charolais from Messrs MEJ Branfield, Clatworthy.
