Auctioneers Comments:

A good entry, being a generally better show, met a stronger trade. Top was a smart, indoor red Limousin from Messrs MJ Tuckett & Partners at 165ppk. A tremendous homebred shapely black Limousin heifer from the same farm achieved 159ppk. A shapely lean Limousin from Messrs TE & J Middleton also hit 160ppk. Other top heifers at 158ppk twice, being a shapely lean Limousin from Mr MC Bailey and a shapely well fleshed Blue from Messrs CJ Radford & Son. Another at 157ppk was a smart, well covered black Limousin from Messrs K & N Crang. Best heifers generally well in to the 150's. Good heifers up to and around 150ppk. Straight sided heifers up to and around 140ppk. Steers also over 160ppk to 161.5ppk for a shapely well covered red Limousin from Messrs DJ & CM Mitchem, who sold others at 158 and 157.5ppk. Messrs CJ Radford & Son also scored with a good, well covered Limousin steer at 160.5ppk. A good lean red Limousin steer from Messrs TJ & MW Hill rose to 159.5ppk. The best of a smart run of lean Charolais and Blondes from Messrs TV & E Wotton rose to 157.5ppk. 157ppk was also achieved by both Mr RE Dury with a clean, lean Simmental and a good, well covered Blonde from Messrs MJ Tuckett & Partners again. Best steers also well into the 150's. Good steers mid 140's. Straight sided steers also up to and around 140ppk. A young Hereford bull achieved 138ppk from Messrs R & B Boundy, which returned at £986.70. Overage to 139.5ppk for a good well covered Limousin from Mr AM Doble. Steers sold to £1104.08 for a strong 701kg

Limousin from Messrs DJ & CM Mitchem, who sold other tremendous steers at £1094.94 and £1093.36. Other heavy weight steers £1082.98, £1081.88 and £1063.13 Messrs TV & E Wotton; £1080.16 Messrs MJ Tuckett & Partners; £1058.75 Messrs CB Coate & Son and £1050.79 from Messrs SW Batten & Sons. Heifers also over £1100 for an outstanding homebred Limousin from Messrs MJ Tuckett & Partners at £1176.60. Over £1000 at £1014.30 was a Charolais from Messrs TV & E Wotton.
