Auctioneers Comments:

A large entry when some really smart cattle were on offer met a firm trade. Many cattle displayed signs of a dry summer and a lack of cake, being very, very lean. Yet fortunately many were of excellent confirmation, which ensured they met ready demand.

Top of the day was 167.5ppk for a shapely well fleshed Limousin heifer from Messrs Day & Son, who sold another at 164ppk. Two near pure red Limousin heifers from Mr R Coate achieved 166.5ppk, lean and extreme and 162.5ppk, shapely and fleshed. Another heifer at 160ppk was a quality well fleshed Limousin from Messrs MD & GJ Curtis. 155.5ppk was achieved by Messrs HWC & JM Butler with a well fleshed Limousin heifer. The Limousin breed took all the top honours amongst the heifers.

A Limousin also topped the steers at 163ppk for a top drawer red type from Mr AR Henson, who sold another such like at 159.5ppk. A tremendous run of lean, good confirmation steers from Mr D Fishleigh rose to 162ppk, with others 157.5ppk and 153ppk.

Ad lib Blue steers from Mr SER Hunt sold well at 157ppk and 152.5ppk. Other top runs sold to £158.5ppk (Limousin) from Messrs AJ Hepper & Son (also 154.5ppk); 156.5ppk (Blonde) Messrs TV & E Wotton (also 152.5ppk) and from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son at 154.5ppk.

Good heifers mid 140's. Steers around 140ppk. Straight sided heifers high 130's. Steers mid to low 130's.

Steers sold to £1,150.28 for a Blonde from Messrs TV & E Wotton, who sold another Blonde at £1,125.00 and a Charolais at £1,093.50. A grand Charolais from Mr TJ Richards achieved £1,111.08. The best of Mr AR Henson's returned at £1,079.17 and Messrs AJ Hepper & Son's at £1,063.04 and of Mr D Fishleigh at £1,053.00. Many steers over the £1000 mark.

Heifers sold to £924.83 (Blonde) for the best of a smart run from Messrs Day & Son. Others over £900 at £920 (Limousin) from Messrs MD & GJ Curtis and £914.34 (Blue) from Messrs RW & SJ Gay.

Overage clean a super trade and sold to 151ppk for a superb Limousin steer from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son, when generally the overage were better finished, reflecting the added time. Another similar from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son at 148.5ppk. Messrs A & SA Edwards achieved 144ppk with a Limousin heifer and 143ppk with a Limousin steer. Prices of note were 130ppk, 129.5ppk and 128ppk for proper British Friesians from Messrs HJ & HB Case Ltd. Also underage Friesians at 125.5ppk, 124.5ppk, 122ppk and 120ppk from Messrs JR & RH Williams. Overage to £940.94 for a Limousin steer from Messrs A & SA Edwards.
