Auctioneers Comments:

An entry, almost 90% up on the previous bank holiday week, met an easier trade after last week's flyer. Direct comparison of the overall averages would suggest quite a sharp drop, however this week's entry saw a range of quality right across the spectrum, with a much larger proportion of poor cattle which dragged the averages back. From stores to too fat; from 407kg to 826kg; from extreme, narrow rejects to some of the smartest cattle you would want to see. Top of the day was 168ppk (1.5ppk up on the week) for a lightweight, well fleshed, shapely Limousin from Mr AM Doble. A run of smart, shapely, lean heifers from Messrs TV & E Wotton achieved 163 and 158ppk (Blondes) and 159ppk (Charolais). The best of a run of indoor heifers from Mr SER Hunt rose to 159ppk (Blue), when a shapely lean heifer (Charolais) from Messrs Vigar Bros achieved 156.5ppk. Better heifers generally 150ppk plus. Good types high 140's. Straight sided types high 130's. Others less. Some super steers on show, which saw the steer average ahead of the heifers. A quality run of Limousins from Mr D Fishleigh crowned the steers at 164.5ppk, with others at 159.5, 158.5, 157, 156 and 155ppk. Messrs TV & E Wotton scored again with a very shapely lean Blonde at 162ppk. Another such, this time from Mr MT Westaway and being a Blue rose to 161ppk. Mr AR Henson brought forward some very smart and well finished steers to peak at 160.5ppk. The best of another good run, this time from Messrs AJ Hepper & Son sold to 159ppk for a Limousin. Some good young bulls forward sold to 145ppk for a Hereford from Messrs R & B Boundy, with others from the same farm at 141.5,

139.5 (Simmentals) and 139ppk (Blue). A very young Blue bull straight off the cow from Mr DR Webber achieved 144ppk. Steers almost broke £1200 at £1188.95 for a 790kg Limousin from Mr AR Henson, who sold others, 792kg at £1152.36 and 670kg at £1075.35. Strong steers from Messrs TV & E Wotton, 751 and 678kg respectively achieved £1115.24 and £1098.36. Grand 804 and 723kg Limousins from Messrs MD & GJ Curtis sold well at £1085.40 and £1084.50. Heifers broke the £1000 barrier at £1039.65 for a 717kg Charolais from Messrs JR & EA Roberts; £1031.79 and £1019.10 for 633 and 645kg Blondes from Messrs TV & E Wotton. Other better heifers over £900. Young bulls sold to £999.05, £990.50 and £959.10 from Messrs R & B Boundy. Overage steers to £959.85 from Mrs EA Richards for 810kg Charolais. Overage heifers sold to £875.79 for a 666kg Limousin from Messrs DH & SM Churchill.
