Top price was £970 (twice) for an outstanding 18m Blue steer from Miss Kate Burrough, Chard, which might go on to show and two grand 27m farm assured (FA) Limousin steers from Mr CJ Chant, Bower Hinton. Mr BC Knapp, Pilning, achieved £960 with a best feeding type red Limousin steer, 25m. Forward 25/26m Limousin steers (FA) from Messrs CJ Parish & Son, Cullompton, rose to £900, with 26/27m feeding Limousin steers from the same farm at £870.

A smart 23m Charolais cross Angus (FA) steer from Messrs W & EA Tratt, Luppitt, sold well at £895. Well grown 21/23m Blue steers from Messrs PT Bale & Son, Lydmarsch met good demand at £890. Other continental steers in the high £800's were the best of a smart run from Messrs M & S Littlejohns, Okehampton, being a 17m Blue steer at £880 and a very shapely red Limousin (15m) from Greenlane Farm, Hallatrow, at the same price. Better steers generally £800 plus. Native steers as ever in keen demand to £875 for an 18m suckler bred Angus (FA) with sire details, from Messrs KMS & ME Dew, Cullompton. Herefords to £825 for 25m steers Mr DA Small, Langport. Some strong black & white steers forward to £780 (overage) from Mr RA Wilkins, Henley. Others to £755 (26m) from Mr FR Butt, Dunkeswell Abbey. Heifers peaked at £838 for 26m FA, good confirmation Limousins from Mr CJ Chant, Bower Hinton again. £835 was received by Mr BC Knapp, Pilning, again, for a fit 25m Limousin. 10 forward 25/27m Limousin heifers (FA) from Messrs CJ Parish & Sons, Cullompton again, achieved £800 twice, with others at £785 and £778. £800 was also achieved by Mr RA Wilkins, Langport again, with an overage Limousin heifer (FA). Fleshed, 21m, FA Simmental heifers from Mr FR Butt, Dunkeswell Abbey again rose to £792. A Charolais cross Blue this time from Messrs W & EA Tratt, Luppitt again, 23m and FA, sold well at £790. Better heifers generally high £700's. Young stores 14/16m FA, being Charolais steers from Mr R North, Upton, sold well at £822. Another, 15m, being a very shapely Limousin from Greenlane Farm, Hallatrow again rose to £795 and a similarly very shapely Blue (13m) from Mr JA Naish, Nailsea, achieved £760. Greenlane Farm also scored again with an exceptional 10m Limousin heifers at £725.
