A better quality entry of 88 milkers saw an improved trade. The second quality frail heifers remain very difficult to sell as we approach the winter. If the cattle were good enough the trade was probably £200 up on last week. The very best are the only ones maintaining the levels of 2009, when 2 Pedigree heifers from Messrs M & K Churchill and Colin Mann of Newton Abbott topped the trade at £2100. Jim Westaway's well bred Pedigree heifers sold to £1920 with others for £1700. Ricky Popham's non pedigree heifers sold to £1840 and £1660. Angus Wiggins had a non Pedigree heifer at £1760. Several others over £1600. Only medium quality cows forward when trade improved to £1400 for Derek Tottle and £1230 Mr P Bowditch. Shorthorn x heifers at £1300 and £1240 for Messrs J & H Snook. Better calf trade, £270 from Messrs P & M Eccles also Messrs AG & RJ Barber.

A big entry, close to four figures again and part of another busy day of 1441 store cattle, stirks and suckler cows.

Very best cattle at former levels but generally trade would be easier. However, the black and white steers were if anything a shade dearer, when fewer were on offer and those that were, were a bit stronger. Top of the day was £945 for a top drawer 16m Blue steer from Greenlane Farm, Hallatrow, who also sold quality 15/16m Angus at £850. Others over £900 were the best of a strong run from Messrs CJ & JC Pine, Meare Green, at £920, being a strong 20m Blue steer (Angus steers from the same farm, 24/25m at £895 and 20/23m Limousin steers at £875); £905 for a very shapely 21m farm assured (FA) steer from Messrs R Ford & Son, Barnstaple and at £900 for the best of a good run of Limousins from Mr MR Adams, Clayhidon, being 22m. Others from the same farm £820 (19/22m). Other Angus steers with pedigree sire details part of the monthly special sale, rose to £895 (27m) from Mr EM Burrige, West Buckland. Well fleshed 23/24m FA Limousin steers from Messrs HC Derryman & Son, Stockland, achieved £880. Herefords, also part of the monthly sale, from Messrs FA & CJ Elsworth, Witheridge, met a final call of £835. Good Charolais steers, 21/26m (FA) from Messrs JT Blewett & Partners, St Ennis, achieved £830, as did strong 26m (FA) Blues from Mr SJ Govier, Crediton.

Heifers peaked at £810 for a well fleshed 24m Simmental from Messrs CJ & JC Pine again. Messrs HC Derryman & Son, again, sold smart 23/26m FA Limousin heifers at £788. Well fleshed 17/18m Charolais from Messrs Mead & Sons, Yeovil rose to £780. The best of a good run of Limousins from Messrs CJ Parish & Sons, Uffculme, sold well at £755 (18m), with others 24/27m at £720. £755 was received by Messrs LF & AJ Bartlett, Gittisham, with a 24m Charolais. A strong 20m (FA) Limousin from Mr RAG Davey, Butterleigh, sold well at £745. Overage Blonde heifers from Mr RS Dorse, Fivehead, rose to £735. Black & white steers peaked at £740 for grand 27/28m types from Messrs R Ford & Son again. Others (25/26m and FA) being well fleshed from Mr THJ Denbee, Wedmore, sold well at £690. Young stores sold to £865 for a well bred shapely 13m (FA) Limousin steer from Mr JJ Cooper, Okehampton, who sold other Charolais (13/16m) at £775, (14/16m) at £705 and (10/12m) at £670. 16m Charolais steer from Messrs A & JL Jackson, Barnstaple, rose to £805. 17/18m Charolais steers from Mr R Widger, Kingsbridge, achieved £800, with another Charolais steer (17m) at £790 from Mrs KR Starr, Dunkeswell. A shapely 14m Limousin heifer from Messrs CR & SL Pople sold particularly well at £710. Another price of note was £725 for a 12m Limousin steer from Messrs Lutton Farm, Wareham, who sold others (12/13m) at £680 and a 17m Limousin heifer at £760. Farm assurance is now critical, when it was most noticeable that non assured cattle over 26 months of age met reduced demand.
