Greenslade Taylor Hunt report a massive Saturday entry to include 52 cows from the dispersal of Messrs SF Grabham & Son of Colyton, Devon. 89 in the commercial section saw a selective trade, when cows were harder to place. Best heifers though created more interest than of late as real quality was in short supply. Norman Taylor's pedigree heifer topped the sale at £1950. Other heifers to £1860 Messrs M & K Churchill; £1830 Mr R Kalloway; £1800 Angus Wiggins and £1780 for a "Jordan" heifer from Mr H Mann. 15% of the entry over £1600. No first quality cows forward. Cow sold to £1281 for a second calver, calved in February giving 26.5kgs, from the Dispersal of Messrs Grabham's. Others to £1186 from the same vendor. Pedigree cows to £1260 for a second calver from Mr PC Pocock.

Greenslade Taylor Hunt report another massive entry for the time of year, almost 400 up on last year, which met another strong trade. A shortage of strong and better cattle ensured when the right types came through the ring, very keen bidding ensued.

Top of the day was £985 for two very strong, best type, feeding Charolais steers (17m/19m) from Messrs JC & PA Chapple, Musbury.

Close to at £955 was a good shape red Limousin steer, 25m and farm assured (FA) from Mr AL Burrough, Wellington. Smart, strong, feeding Limousin steers (27m FA) from Mr CJ Chant, Bower Hinton achieved £925. Another over £900 was a strong 28m FA Blue at £905 from Mr AW J Hillier, Corsham. Strong feeding steers generally high £800's. Native steers to £858 for a 20m Angus from Messrs Brems Trustees, Blandford Forum. Others to £850 for fleshed 28m (FA) steers with sire details from Mr R Takle, Exton.

Black and whites rose to £720 for forward 25m FA steers from Mr CG Carbin, Compton Dundon, who sold others at £680. Another, 26m and FA at £685 from Messrs KJ & CP Dunn, Dinder.

Heifers also over £900 at £925 for a finished 28m FA Blonde from Messrs JC & TG Merchant. Well fleshed, forward 25m/26m red Limousins from Mr BC Knapp rose to £868. Mr CW Dunn scored with a shapely 25m Limousin at £865. Shape in demand when a 28m finished Charolais from Mr AL Burrough achieved £855. The same price was received by Mr RW Bowden, Barnstaple, with a strong 25m Blue (FA). Best feeding heifers to £800 for an extremely shaped Blue (15m) from Messrs RJ & PJ Northover. Others 25m/26m, being FA Blondes from Messrs PC Lyons & Son, Rowberrow achieved £780. Pure bred Limousins, 16m from Mr R Coate, Broomfield rose to £775 and £745.

Younger stores keenly sought to £795 for well grown 15m Limousin steers from Mr BWT Smith, Chippenham. Others also £795 and 15m being Angus from Mr RA Reed. Quality 15m Charolais from Mr EJ Browse, Halberton, achieved £790.

Organic steers in the monthly organic sale also to the fore at £765 for 14m Charolais from Miss JN Body, Biddisham.

### (267) Beef Breeds

Greenslade Taylor Hunt report another excellent entry, trade continues to ease as feed and straw price pressures remain. Nonetheless, averages very similar to last week for bulls, which were well sought to a top of £356 for a fine Blue from Mr LL Tidball, with Charolais to £342 Messrs DJ & SE Bristol. Simmentals to £338 Mr AC Loxton. Other Continentals to £330 (x2). Most good bulls £240-£280, mediums £170-£220, plainer bulls around £150. Heifers not quite so sharp though quality still at a premium with Blues to £270, £265 and £258 Mr D Chipp, Weymouth. Limousins (8 weeks) to £265 and a lovely Charolais at £241 Raymond Pike. Plenty of smart heifers £160-£200 but it was the plainer heifers, particularly Limousins, which looked less dear. Native breeds still keenly contested though heifers not quite so firm. Angus bulls to £240 and heifers to £202 while Hereford bulls sold very well to average over £200. Heifers to £175. Smart Montbeliardes to £185.
