Where have all the cows gone? After last week's excellent trade many more were anticipated. When only 114 were penned, a super trade resulted and many, many more could have been sold to advantage. Top of the day was 118.5ppk for a grand 916kg Charolais from Messrs J & C Perrett. Close behind was Mr MJ Pidsley, at 115ppk, with a well fleshed Angus and also in the vanguard were Mr RD Churchill at 112.5ppk (Charolais); Messrs M Harrison Partners at 110ppk (Charolais); 109.5ppk both Mr RM Dod (Angus) and Mr DE Abraham (Charolais). Half meat sucklers around 100ppk and grazers/feeders again up to 100ppk. Sucklers sold to £1085.46 for the outstanding Charolais from Messrs J & C Perrett. Others £866.80, Charolais, Messrs M Harrison Partners; £788.63, Charolais, Mr RD Churchill; £783.24, Angus, Mr BJ Guppy; £778.51, Hereford, Mr THJ Denbee; £777.38, Angus, Mr MJ Pidsley and £746.79, Angus, Mr RM Dod. Many more £700 plus, which is excellent for the time of year. Black and whites met a good trade again. Top was 103ppk for a best type from Messrs AJ Gay & Son Ltd. Other better types at 100.5ppk from Messrs RKM House & Son and 99.5ppk from Messrs GJ & ED Porter. Many, many good meat cows 92 to 97.5ppk, generally a super show of Black and Whites for which Vendors must be congratulated. Meat with belly 85ppk plus. Steakers 77 to 92ppk dependent on associated waste. Plain boners 55 to 75ppk dependent on how severe, but still looked very well sold. Black and white cows sold to £804 (800kg) from Messrs RKM House & Son, who sold another (845kg) at £798.53. Others to £798.88 (913kg) for the best of a good run from Messrs AW Hewlett & Son and £750.75 (770kg) Messrs FE Hill & Son. Many £700 plus which is again wonderful for this time of year. Stock bulls to £956.44 for a Limousin from Messrs LJ Waygood & Son. The weather at the time of writing has not broken and with this prolonged spell of weather, cows are being milked on at grass. Don't be nervous, don't be shy, catch the trade before the autumn flush.

To prevent the escape of livestock from the pannage area, please ensure:-

Outer loading bay gates are securely chained to vehicle tailboard gates when unloading or loading stock. **It will be deemed negligence if this is not done.**

Second set of loading bay gates to be secured with chain (cattle) and sliding fastener (sheep) after unloading.

Gates are always to be left in closed position when vacating loading bays.

In the event of an escape raise alarm and ensure entrance and exit gates are closed. Once entrance and exit gates are closed, then proceed to recapture stock.

Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

All cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 require two tags.

Somerset Trading Standards require any such cattle presented at market with less than two tags to be returned home under licence. Please ensure all cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 have a tag in each ear before leaving home. If a tag is lost in transit, please present tag to STS Animal Health representative for onward licence and sale. If you are unable to replace a missing tag due to ill health or health and safety issues and would like to use market facilities, please write to Somerset Trading Standards Service, Animal Health and Welfare, Chelston, Wellington, Somerset, TA21 9HP, fax : 01823 664199 or email: ahw@somerset.gov.uk to request permission.
