An increased number and what a trade. Some really good coloured and particularly black and white cows forward, when near half the entry made 100ppk and over. Sucklers rose to 131ppk for a smart Limousin from Messrs AR & J Willmington, who sold another at 129.5ppk and an Angus at 116.5ppk. Another Angus, this time from Messrs AB, RG & JL Darby achieved 122.5ppk, with good Blues from the same farm at 116 and 115.5ppk. Better sucklers generally 110 to 115ppk. Sucklers sold to £970.96 for a grand Charolais from Messrs CA Gamlin & Son. Others over £900 at £949.50, being a strong Limousin from Mr C Grant-Ives and £929.77 for another strong Limousin from Messrs MR & GE Ricketts. Better coloured cows over £800. Black and whites in exceptional demand. Top being 121.5ppk for a heifer from Messrs Garrett Bros. Young cows to 112.5ppk from Messrs Holt Farms Ltd, who sold another at 109.5ppk. Other young cows to 110.5ppk from Messrs R Lucas & Son and at 105.5ppk from Messrs Bridgwater College. Older Black and White cows to 111.5ppk from Messrs Holt Farms Ltd again. Others at 109.5ppk, Messrs DW Rowe & Son; 109ppk, Messrs FE Hill & Son; 108.5ppk, Messrs R Lucas & Son again; 108ppk, Messrs Bridgwater College again and Messrs AB, RG & JL Darby again. Good meat cows 100pk plus. Half meat cows 95ppk. Steakers and were from 75 to 95ppk, with the top end of them looking the dearest sold for a long time. Boners 55 to 75ppk, with again the top end particularly dear as abattoirs compete for throughput. Cows sold to £950.48 for a boat of a cow from Messrs FE Hill & Son, who sold another at £892.38. Others over £800 at £834.20 from Messrs RH Groves & Sons; £809.67, Messrs LG Heal & Son; £808.50 and £807.24 from Messrs R Lucas & Sons and £806.02 from Messrs SW Batten & Sons. Many meat cows £750 plus. Stock bulls also very well sold at £1089 for a Charolais from Mr J Wyld and £1004.40 for a very smart Devon from Messrs J & R Stanbury. One or two plum clean forward to 134.5ppk for a red Hereford heifer from Messrs TE & SJ Popham. Many, many more cows could have been sold to advantage. Gates are always to be left in closed position when vacating loading bays.  
In the event of an escape raise alarm and ensure entrance and exit gates are closed. Once entrance and exit gates are closed, then proceed to recapture stock.
